Objectives

Eligibility & Other Conditions

The course is of one year duration and is divided into three terms. The candidates who have secured 50% or more in Graduation / Post Graduation are eligible to apply for the course.

Each teacher trainee has to opt for two courses (one from each column) provided he/she has done his/her graduation/post graduation in the same.

- Educational Measurement and Evaluation
- Distance Education

Each teacher trainee has to opt for one course only.

Admission Procedure

- Admission to B.Ed. shall be made on the basis of the inter se merit determined on the basis of Aggregate percentage of marks in Qualifying Exam (Graduation/Post Graduation, whichever is better), Group Discussion and Personal Interview.
- On the basis of marks obtained in the Qualifying Exam (Graduation/Post Graduation), a provisional Merit list will be prepared to short list the candidates, to be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The candidates short listed for Group Discussion and Personal Interview shall attend the same at Lingaya's University, Faridabad, at their own cost.
- While preparing the final list in order of Merit, 70% Weightage will be given to the marks obtained in Qualifying Exam, 15% to Group Discussion and 15% to Personal Interview.
- In case of more than one candidate scoring the same marks in final list, the candidate, who is senior in age, shall rank higher in order of Merit.
- The selected candidate shall have to deposit the Fee* as per the Schedule**.
- The second list, if required shall be displayed as per the Schedule.
- The selected candidate shall have to deposit the Fee as per the Schedule.
- In case the candidate whose name appears in the second list does not deposit the Fee by due date as per the Schedule, he/she loses his/her claim on the seat allotted to him/her. Such seats shall be filled on the basis of the Merit of the Aggregate percentage of the Qualifying Exam.

Note: Compartment case(s) of 2009 i.e. current year will not be considered for admission for the academic session 2009-10.

- a) **The Candidates appearing in the qualifying examination are also eligible to apply provided** they are able to produce the proof of having acquired minimum prescribed qualifications at the time of admission.
- b) If the total result of qualifying examination is not declared by the concerned Board/University till the date of admission his/her

admission in that case will be provisional subject to the following conditions:

- i. The candidate will have to submit the result of qualifying examination proving his/her eligibility on or before 30-09-2009.
 - ii. In case the candidate fails to submit his/her final result of qualifying examination in the manner prescribed under (i) above to prove his/her eligibility on or before 30-09-2009, what so ever the reason may be, his/her admission will be treated as null and void and the entire fee will be forfeited.
- c) It is further clarified that provisional admission will be considered only in such cases where the result of the qualifying examination has not been declared by the concerned Board/University in its totality. In case the result has been declared by the concerned Board/University but it has not been declared in a specific case, for any reason, such case will NOT be considered under provisional admission category.
- d) There will be no rounding-off of the percentage of marks of qualifying examination while deciding the basic eligibility of any candidate for admission.

2. Refund of Fee

The admitted candidate who wishes to withdraw his/her candidature should apply for withdrawal of admission by due date (Refer to '**Key Dates**'). Such candidates will be refunded the fee deposited by them after deducting Rupees One thousand only. **NO REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF ADMISSION SHALL BE ENTERTAINED AFTER THE LAST DATE OF WITHDRAWAL.**

3. Physical Fitness

The applicant must be in good mental and physical health and should be free from any physical defect which is likely to interfere with his/her studies including active outdoor duties required of a professional. Accordingly, all the students shall be required to submit Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per the given format.

*** The Annual Fee consists of Tuition Fee, Development Fee, Student Welfare & Training Fee, University Examination Fee, University Registration Fee etc.**

The candidates who accept the offer of admission are required to deposit the Fee as given below:

- i) Amount to be paid at time of admission: Rs. 55,500/-**
ii) Amount to be paid by 31-12-2009: Rs. 48,000/-

In case the student wishes to pay the whole fee in one go, he/she will be given a special rebate of Rupees Five Thousand only.

The admitted students shall be provided with laptop, blazer, lab coat and set of prescribed text books at no extra cost.

Special Instructions

The students applying for B.Ed programme should go through the guidelines for filling the application form which shall be provided along with the OMR Sheet (Application Form). The candidate who is applying on the basis of Post Graduation marks should darken the oval next to OTHERS given in the field 12a of OMR Sheet and he/she should provide the information asked for in field no. 12b, 12f and 12g. The applicant should ignore the fields which are not relevant to his/her course of study.
